What to do if you are arrested?

If arrested and taken to police station:

- You will be informed of the grounds for your arrest and you have a right to independent legal advice.
- For most offences, the police can take your photo, finger prints & DNA
 can be taken at the police station. If you are under 18 an appropriate adult
 needs to be present for this to happen. There are some offences, for
 which the police cannot take these samples. If you want to check about
 this, you can ask your solicitor.
- You have the right to see a doctor if you are unwell.

If you are under 18, you have to have an appropriate adult (parent/legal guardian or other responsible adult) with you at the police station and throughout the police station process.

Unless certain conditions are met, you can inform someone of your arrest.

DO NOT answer any questions about the offence from the police until you have spoken to a lawyer from our firm.
